Immunogen

Peptide with sequence C-PNPSIQHISQT, from the internal region of the protein sequence according to NP_001073981.1.

Purification and Storage

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin.

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

Applications Tested

Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:8000.

Western blot: Preliminary experiments in Human Brain (Cerebellum), Kidney, Lung and Pancreas lysates gave no specific signal but low background (at antibody concentration up to 1µg/ml). We would appreciate any feedback from people in the field - have any results been reported with other antibodies/lysates?

Immunoprecipitation: Immunoprecipitation by EB09818 from lysates of HEK293 transfected and overexpressing FLAG-HA-BICC1. Precipitation works best in the presence of SDS. Data kindly provided by anonymous customer.

Species Reactivity

Tested: Human

Expected from sequence similarity: Human, Rat, Dog, Cow

HEK293 overexpressing Human BICC1 with N-terminal FLAG, probed with rabbit anti-BCC1 in Western Blot after IP using either EB09818 or anti-FLAG antibody in the presence or absence of SDS.
