## **Immunogen**

Peptide with sequence C-HVETRAHAEERLLKK, from the internal region of the protein sequence according to NP 000735.1.

Please note the peptide is available for sale.

## **Purification and Storage**

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin.

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

#### **Applications Tested**

Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:64000.

Western blot: Approx 70kDa band observed in Rat Brain lysates (calculated MW of 70.0kDa according to Human NP\_000735.1and of 70.2kDa according to Rat NP\_077330.1). Recommended concentration: 1-3μg/ml. An additional band of unknown identity was also consistently observed at 22kDa. This band was successfully blocked by incubation with the immunising peptide. We would appreciate any feedback from people in the field - have any such results been reported with other antibodies/lysates? Have any further splice variants/modified forms been reported? ~75kDa confirmed in both human and rat tissues as the glycoprotein by an anonymous customer.

This antibody was shown unfit for immune precipitation.

## **Species Reactivity**

Tested: Human, Rat

Expected from sequence similarity: Human, Mouse, Rat, Dog, Cow

EB08852 (0.3 $\mu$ g/ml) staining of Rat Brain lysate (35 $\mu$ g protein in RIPA buffer). Primary incubation was 1 hour. Detected by chemiluminescence.
