Immunogen

Peptide with sequence C-LFKDGDQKLEK, from the internal region of the protein sequence according to NP_000093.1.

Please note the peptide is available for sale.

Purification and Storage

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide. Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin.

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

Applications Tested

Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:64000.

Western blot: Approx 60kDa band observed in Human Ovary lysates (calculated MW of 57.4kDa according to NP_000093.1). Recommended concentration: 0.1-0.3µg/ml. Primary incubation was 1 hour.

IHC: In paraffin embedded Human Adenal Gland shows strong granular staining of the cytoplasm in medulla cells. Recommended concentration: 3-5µg/ml.

Species Reactivity

Tested: Human Expected from sequence similarity: Human, Cat, Dog EB07219 (0.3µg/ml) staining of Human Ovary lysate (35µg protein in RIPA buffer). Detected by chemiluminescence.

EB07219 (3.8µg/ml) staining of paraffin embedded Human Adrenal Gland. Steamed antigen retrieval with citrate buffer pH 6, AP-staining.
