Immunogen

Peptide with sequence C-KNQFLDLNLKKEDKE, from the internal region of the protein sequence according to NP_001095856.1.

Please note the peptide is available for sale.

Purification and Storage

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin.

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

Applications Tested

Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:32000.

Western blot: Preliminary experiments gave an approx 27kDa band in Human Colon and Testis lysates and in cell lines NIH 3T3, A431 and Kelly after 0.1µg/ml antibody staining. Please note that currently we cannot find an explanation in the literature for the band we observe given the calculated size of 40.4kDa according to NP_001095856.1. The 27kDa band was successfully blocked by incubation with the immunizing peptide.

IHC: In paraffin embedded Human Small Intestine shows staining of endocrine cells amongst the enterocytes. Recommended concentration: 3-6µg/ml.

Tested: Human

Expected from sequence similarity: Human, Mouse, Rat, Dog

EB08224 (3.8μg/ml) staining of paraffin embedded Human Small Intestine. Steamed antigen retrieval with citrate buffer pH 6, AP-staining.
