Immunogen

Peptide with sequence QQTSVRREDKCETD, from the internal region of the protein sequence according to NP_000852.1.

Purification and Storage

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin.

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

Applications Tested

Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:16000.

Western blot: Approx 55kDa band observed in Human Heart lysates (calculated MW of 55.8kDa according to NP_000852.1). Recommended concentration: 0.5-1.5µg/ml.

IHC: In paraffin embedded Human Lung shows membranous staining of epitheilial cells in tertiar bronchus and in alveoli. Recommended concentration, 2-4µg/ml.


Species Reactivity
