Important Comments: The immunizing peptide represents part of the extracellular

domain, and it does not overlap any known glycosite.

Immunogen

Peptide with sequence SNCPDGQSTAKT, from the internal region of the protein sequence according to NP_000192.2.

Please note the peptide is available for sale.

Purification and Storage

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

Applications Tested

Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:4000.

Immunofluorescence: Strong expression of the protein seen in the plasma membrane and cytoplasm of U251 cells. Recommended concentration: 10µg/ml.

Species Reactivity

Tested: Human

Expected from sequence similarity: Human

EB11753 Immunofluorescence analysis of paraformaldehyde fixed U251 cells, permeabilized with 0.15% Triton. Primary incubation 1hr (10ug/ml) followed by Alexa Fluor 488 secondary antibody (2ug/ml), showing cytoplasmic and membrane staining. The nuclear stain is DAPI (blue). Negative control: Unimmunized goat IgG (10ug/ml) followed by Alexa Fluor 488 secondary antibody (2ug/ml).
