Immunogen

Peptide with sequence C-DPKSKEEDKHLK, from the C Terminus of the protein sequence according to NP_001035147.1; NP_000573.1; NP_001035149.1.

Purification and Storage

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin.

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

Applications Tested

Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:32000.

Western blot: Approx 35kDa band observed in lysates of cell line MOLT4. This band corresponds to the cleavage product from the 60kDa glycoprotein (calculated MW of 33.8kDa according to NP_000573.1). Recommended concentration: 0.1-0.3µg/ml.

Species Reactivity

Tested: Human

Expected from sequence similarity: Human, Mouse, Rat, Dog

EB06825 (0.1 µg/ml) staining of lysates of cell line MOLT4 (35 µg protein in RIPA buffer). Primary incubation was 1 hour. Detected by chemiluminescence.
