Immunogen

Peptide with sequence C-HLKTQAEQLHNH, from the C Terminus of the protein sequence according to NP_000107.1; NP_851828.1; NP_851829.1; NP_851830.1.

Purification and Storage

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin.

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

Applications Tested

Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:32000.

Western blot: Approx 28kDa band observed in Human Heart lysates (calculated MW of 33.5kDa according to NP_000107.1, 30.2kDa according to NP_851828.1, 31.7kDa according to NP_851829.1 and 28.5 according to NP_851830.1). Recommended concentration: 0.3-1.0 µg/ml.

Species Reactivity

Tested: Human

Expected from sequence similarity: Human, Mouse, Rat, Dog

EB06954 (0.3μg/ml) staining of Human Heart lysate (35μg protein in RIPA buffer). Primary incubation was 1 hour. Detected by chemiluminescence.
